### **Jake Bergey – Former National Champion, All Pro NLL & MLL**

Former Salisbury State University 3x First Team All-American.  
Former Philadelphia Wings Player and All Pro 1999-2004 and world Championships in '98. Former Baltimore Bayhawk player.  
Played for the USA indoor team in 2007 and was named MVP



### **Alex Smith – Current Head Coach Colorado State University**

2010 marked a new era for **Colorado State University** men's lacrosse as Alex Smith took the helm for his first full season as head coach. Graduating from Colorado State in 2003 as a goaltender, Smith was a part of three national championship teams as a player. Serving as an assistant coach to lacrosse legend Flip Naumburg, Smith and the Rams won their fourth MCLA title in 2006, making Naumburg and Smith the only people in MCLA history with four national championship rings. Since graduating, Smith became the first player in the MCLA to play for Major League Lacrosse's Denver Outlaws, where he served as a goaltender from 2006-2010. He also served as an assistant coach and Offensive Coordinator for the Outlaws in 2010 and 2011.



### **Mike Busza- Former Philadelphia Wing player**

Former Philadelphia Wings and Boston Cannons midfielder. In 1995 Mike was selected to the All American team from Penn State University. Mike was also selected to the U-19 team in 1992 to represent the United States that went on to win the World Championship. In 1992 Mike was selected High School All American from Ridley High School. Current Asst. coach Radnor High School.



### **Pat Cullinan – Former Head Coach St Joes University**

Pat brings with him 23 years of college coaching experience to PYLA & Team Philadelphia. He served as an assistant coach at West Chester University from 1988 – 1998 and head coach from 1998 – 2003. Cullinan then served as an assistant coach at Saint Joseph's University for the 2003 -2004 season and its head coach from 2004-2011.

At West Chester, Cullinan was named New York Collegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2002 and 2003, while in 2006 he was recognized at Saint Joseph's as the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Coach of the Year. In addition Cullinan also served as Chairman of the United States Lacrosse Men's Division Convention Committee from 2006-2008.



### **Jon Reynolds – Current Head Coach Marymount**

Jon is in his seventh season as the head coach of the Marymount University men's lacrosse team. He sits in third place on the total victories for any coach in program history.

Reynolds took over a program that went 4-12 the year before and has posted better seasons in each of his five years at the helm. His signature win came in the 2008 season with a victory over 18th-ranked Hampden-Sydney and the Saints' three Capital Athletic Conference wins in 2007 are tied for the most in a season since 2001.

A four-year player for Marymount from 1997-00, Reynolds returned to his alma mater after five years as the head coach of nearby Yorktown High School. With the Patriots, he posted a .667 winning-percentage and made the regional playoffs each season. Reynolds was tabbed District and Regional Coach of the Year in 2002.



### **Tom Slate – Current Denver Outlaw Head Coach, MLL**

***Currently the President of Lacrosse Evolution and Head Coach of the Denver Outlaws, MLL.*** Tom played professional lacrosse for the Philadelphia Wings, NLL and with the Baltimore Bayhawks, MLL. Tom represented team USA at the World Indoor Lacrosse competition. Tom was selected High School All American, and Captain of the 1992 Springfield High School Lacrosse State Champions. Coach Slate was an Assistant Coach for the World Champion Philadelphia Barrage and now Head Coach of the San Francisco Dragons. Tom's spring job is Head Coach of the 2007 State Champion Downingtown East High School. In doing so became the first Player and Head Coach to win a state championship in Pennsylvania Lacrosse History.
